- 1. CDOT Formal Training Courses and on the job training (In house)
- 2. NHI Maintenance Leadership Academy (Industry Driven Training)
- 3. College (AAS) Degree Program (Personal/Professional Development)



Train and develop competent and effective maintenance professionals and maintenance leaders!











MAINTENANCE TRAINING ACADEMY:

- ✓ Provides the foundation to our Maintenance Leaders and Operators. (Primary method of educating)
- ✓ Instructors are current maintenance leaders (60 senior supervisors)
- ✓ Regulated by our Division of Highway Maintenance (1M budget with a small dedicated professional staff)
- ✓ Curriculum focused on initial and refresher maintenance training program. (Each year new focus area, TIMS/Safety/etc.)
- ✓ Training ensures our maintenance workers have current, relevant, and skills-based training to perform individual and crew-based maintenance tasks. (Provides universal foundation)
